

Schedule of Fees: 2017-Entry Indian Students

Fee Type	Amount	Description
College Fees	₹ 19,00,000 annually	All the costs incurred in the usual course of education by the College, as outlined in the Terms & Conditions & Schedule of Fees. Payable by 1 st July of the commencing academic year unless an alternative Fee Installment Plan has been agreed upon in writing (see below)
Scholarship Award	Variable	College provided financial support, National Committee funding and other special sponsorship provisions, which are adjusted against the payable fees. All college provided scholarships are needs-based i.e. determined through an assessment of the family's financial status.
Enrollment Deposit (Non-Refundable)	10% of Parental Contribution or ₹ 25,000 (whichever is higher)	Payment to secure enrollment. Due within two weeks of receipt of the Admission Letter & Fee Invoice. Adjustable against College Fees.
Caution Money (Refundable)	₹ 25,000	Refundable subsequent to final departure from the College, after deducting sums due to the College for damages or other charges, if applicable. Caution money is refunded no later than 6 months from departure date and returned only via bank transfer.
Project Week & Travel Week (Year 1)	₹ 30,000	All-inclusive costs for first-year students participating in mandatory College organized Travel & Project Weeks (2 trips, 7 - 10 days each). Please note Year 2 trips must be self-organized and self-funded.

Fee Payment Plans

Fee Payment Plans must be agreed in writing with Admissions (admissions@muwci.net) and the Student Finances Office (studentfinances@muwci.net) at the time of accepting the Offer of Admission. Fee Payment Plans indicated below are applicable to remaining fees payable, after remittance of the Enrollment Deposit. All late fees or lapses in agreed upon payment schedules will attract a **1.5% penalty per month on the overdue amounts**.

Payment Plan	Installments	Description
Option A (Default)	2 Installments due - 1 st July 2017 - 1 st July 2018	Pay annual fees due for the academic year by 1 st July, prior to the commencement of each academic year. There is no interest or discount applicable in this default option.
Option B (Discounted)	1 Installment due - 1 st July 2017	The sponsor must pay total fees due for both years by 1 st July, before the commencement of Academic Year 2017-2018. Fees for Academic Year 2018-2019 are discounted at 7% p.a.
Option C (With Interest)	4 Installments due - 1 st July 2017 - 1 st January 2018 - 1 st July 2018 - 1 st January 2019	Pay fees bi-annually in four installments before the dates mentioned prior to each academic term. The January installments are chargeable at 6% interest (12% per annum -- i.e. the amount payable on 1 st January is ₹ 106 for every ₹ 100 due. A payment after this date will be charged as per the 1.5% monthly penalty. i.e. the amount payable after 1 st January is ₹ 109 for every ₹ 100 due, and so on)
